

The Marquette County Board of Canvassers met on Wednesday, August 3, 2022 at 1:00 P.M. in the County Clerk's Office, Courthouse, 234 Baraga Avenue, Marquette, Michigan to Canvass the Results of the August 2, 2022 Primary Election.

Chairperson Doreen Takalo called the meeting to order. Present: Doreen Takalo, Pete Dishnow, Cindy Constantino and Bob Niemi and Linda Talsma, County Clerk. Absent and Excused: None

Guests: Tonya Nelson, Chief Deputy Marquette County Clerk, David Allen (League of Women Voters), Stephanie Gencheff, Pri Burnham (LWV) and Jim Gallant.

It was moved by Pete Dishnow, seconded by Bob Niemi and unanimously carried by voice vote that Board of Canvassers waive the reading and approve the minutes of the May 3, 2022 Election Canvass. Motion adopted (4-0)

Pete Dishnow motioned to allow a 2-Minute Public Comment as there were public present. Second by Bob Niemi. Motion adopted. (4-0)

Public Comment: Jim Gallant, Skandia, was present and explained the rules of order to the Board of Canvassers. No other public comment came before the board.

Pete Dishnow motioned to adjourn the meeting and reconvene at 11:00 am on August 4th, 2022 in the County Clerk's Office, concluding with most of the Townships Canvassed. The Stored Containers were sealed and placed in the County Clerk's Vault until The Board reconvenes (53508 & 53509). The Board will pick up where they left off on the canvass when they reconvene. Second by Cindy Constantino. Motion adopted (4-0)

Chairperson Doreen Takalo reconvened the Board of Canvassers meeting on August 4th, 2022 to canvass the Election Results from the August 2, 2022 Primary Election. The Board reconvened at 11:10 am with the full board present (Doreen Takalo, Pete Dishnow, Cindy Constantino and Bob Niemi) and Linda Talsma, Marquette County Clerk.

Guests: Tonya Nelson, Chief Deputy Marquette County Clerk, David Allen (League of Women Voters), Stephanie Gencheff and Jim Gallant.

The Board of Canvassers proceeded to canvass the August Primary Election. The Results are as follows:

NEGAUNEE PUBLIC SCHOOLS - OPERATING MILLAGE PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its full revenue per pupil foundation allowance and restores millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Negaunee Public Schools, Marquette County, Michigan, be renewed by 18.2961 mills (\$18.2961 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 10 years, 2024 to 2033, inclusive, and also be increased by .5 mill (\$0.50 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 10 years, 2024 to 2033, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and 18 mills are levied in 2024 is approximately \$2,137,331 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2023 levy and the addition of millage which will be levied only to the extent necessary to restore millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the "Headlee" amendment to the Michigan Constitution of 1963)?
